Why do we suggest comprehension for fluent readers?

So they only concentrate on comprehending the questions asked rather than focusing on the decoding of words.

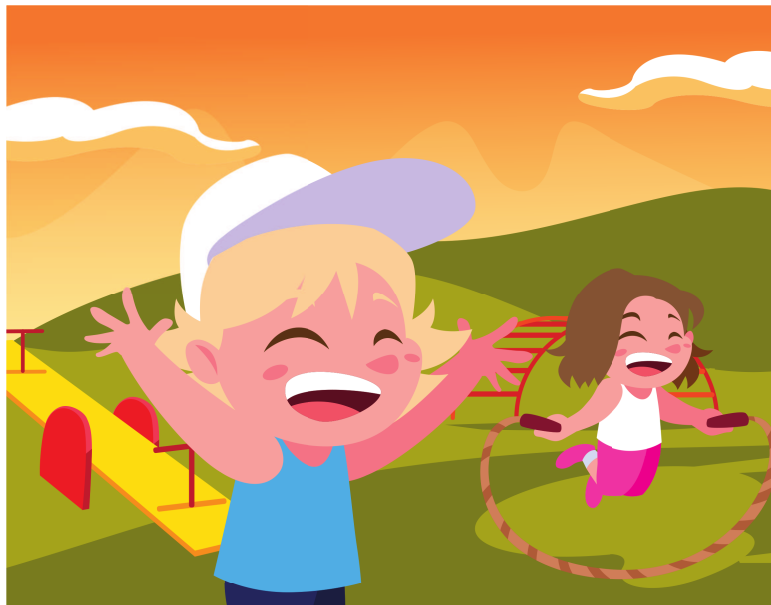

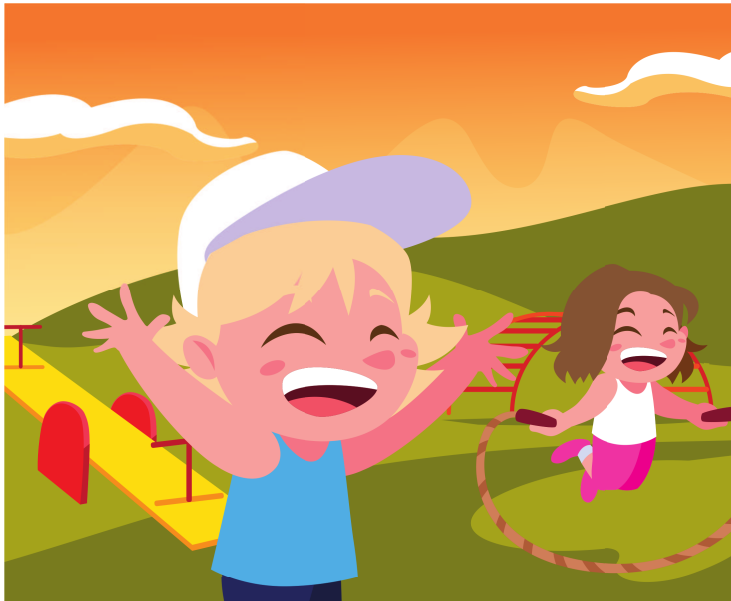
